Juniors: Dependent on entries

To help you to select the correct round, please read the following:-

Western rounds are made up of eight dozen arrows, four dozen at each of the following distances:-

- Western:** - 60 and 50 yards (Gents, Ladies, boys 16-17 years)
- Short Western:** - 50 and 40 yards (Girls 16-17 and boys 14-15 years)
- Junior Western:** - 40 and 30 yards (Girls 13-15 and Boys 12-13 years)
- Short Junior Western:** - 30 and 20 yards (Girls under 13 and Boys under 12)

Junior rounds may be subject to change if proposed new rules are ratified.

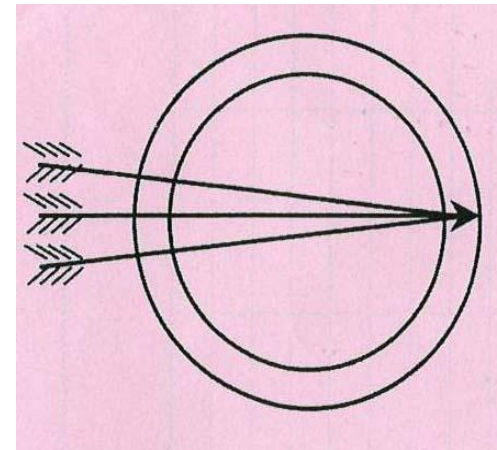
